## 2018 - Topic #8 - Primary Colors of Safety

#### **Reason for this Blast:**

The color of a safety sign can be the first indication of the hazards and the severity of the hazards. Typical guidance on coordinating hazards with specific sign colors and verbiage are:

#### **Color Identification:**

#### <mark>RED</mark> –

- Fire protection equipment and apparatuses
- Danger safety cans, flammable liquids, biohazards, danger signs
- Equipment stops and Emergency stops

#### <mark>YELLOW</mark> —

- Caution designation and caution signs
- Physical hazards striking against, stumbling, falling, tripping, and caught in/between

#### Signage:

#### DANGER DANGER SIGNS

- Immediate danger
- Special precautions are necessary



#### CAUTION SIGNS

- To warn against potential hazards
- To caution against unsafe practices
